QUARTERMAIN + TARRY + STOCKMAN

L'MEDIA RELEASE; Sound, rhythm, and graphic phenomena at the Gallery

FRIDAY, 8 FEBRUARY 8.30PM

Three artists—Joel Quartermain, of Eskimo Joe, Jon Tarry, Associate Professor of Visual Arts at The University of Western Australia, and Jon Stockman, of Karnivool—combine their creative forces for a series of original works that amplify sound, rhythms, and graphic phenomena, in a mesmerizing performance at the Lawrence Wilson Art Gallery.

Quartermain, Tarry and Stockman have developed three twenty-minute sets: Eyes of the Child amplifies the first glances of unknowing, while Blood Road explores traveling, looping and navigating the back roads and superhighways through a rear-view mirror. The evening concludes with Nova Wake, a work that dissolves all, and charters pathways through seemingly impossible missions.

Music art, sound art, and visual art will take you over the precipice into a primordial realm. This will be a unique collaboration by three of Australia's most talented artists.
